- **Variety:** Carmenère 70% - Cabernet sauvignon 30%
- **Vineyard:** Apalta, Santa Cruz, Colchagua Valley
- **Harvest:** Manual
- **Soil:** Granitic
- **Climate:** Semiarid Mediterranean
- **Precipitation:** 524 mm (20,6 in)
- **Plantation:** 145 Ha (324 acres), but only 30 ha (72 acres) for wine Neyen.
- **Age:** 35 - 120 years
- **Yield:** 5 - 6 ton\ ha - (2 - 2,5 ton\ acre)
- **Barrel:** 14 month in French oak.
- **Colour:** Intense ruby red.
- **Nose:** Intense aroma of red fruits and a ubtle of flower, with very elegant final.
- **Palate:** A fresh and dense attack. Subtle spices. Rounded and persistent finish in the mouth and a very good balance. Mature and soft tanins give us an elegant and exceptional wine.
- **Alcohol:** 14%
- **Total acidity:** 3,65 meq/l
- **pH:** 3,72
