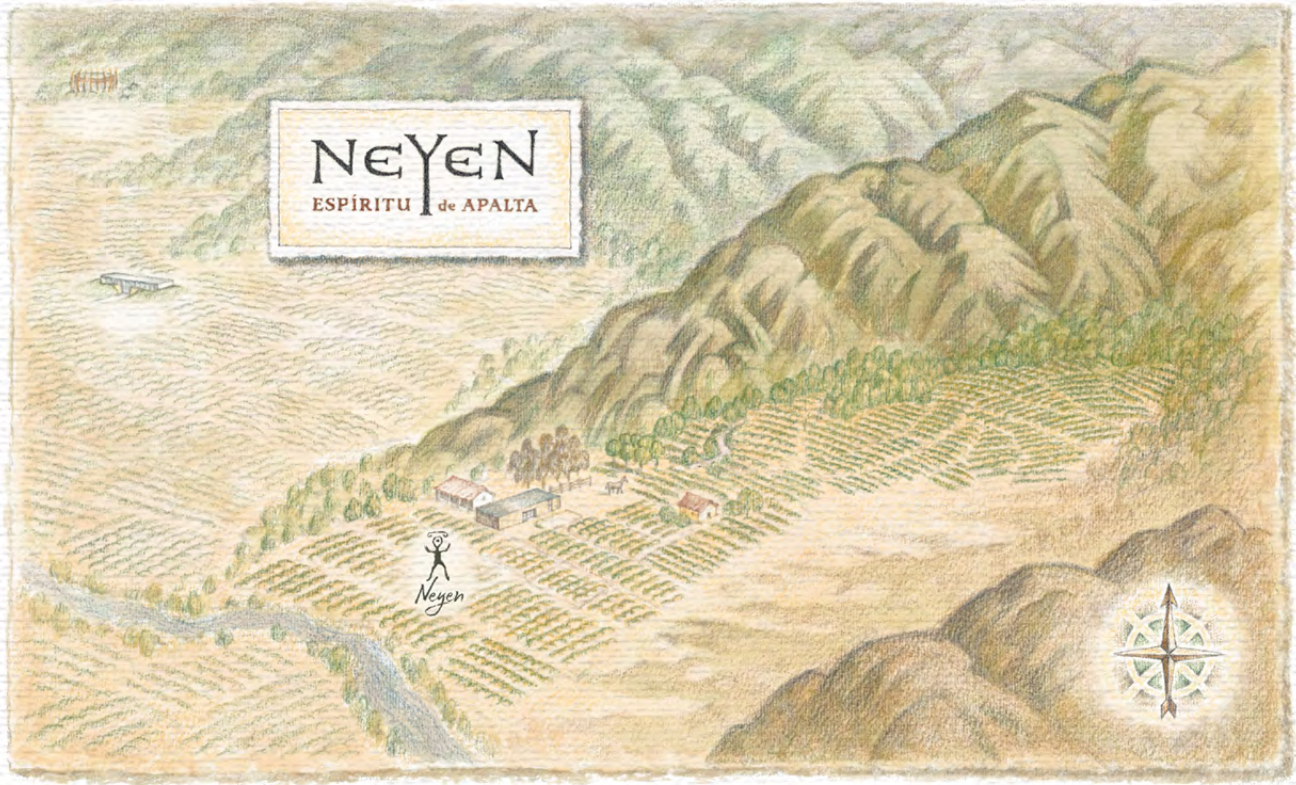
**PALATE:** A fresh and concentrated entry. Subtle spice.

Round and well balanced with a persistent finish.
