

Negen, ancestral spirit of Apalta Valley, is born from the Andes Mountains, fruit of the sun & centennial vineyard. Prodigious wine, wise blend of Carmenere and Cabernet Sauvignon.

VARIETALS: Carmenere 55%, Cabernet Sauvignon 45%

OAK TREATMENT: 12 months in French oak, 70% new

**ALCOHOL:** 14.1%

**PALATE:** A soft and concentrated entry, with structured, silky tannins, dark fruit flavors and notions of toasted oak and vanilla. A plush wine that is nicely balanced and has a persistent finish.
